To All Members of the Abertillery Learning Community including Parents/Carers,


The Local Authority has provided the Governing Body with the following information in relation to the Tillery Street Campus:

Parents and staff are informed that Tillery St Campus has some Aluminium Composite Material (ACM) cladding similar but not the same as at Grenfell tower. We are advised by the Local Authority that there is no need for concern and the Local Authority are currently making an assessment to see if there is any potential risk. The cladding was installed to current Building Regulations so there should be no risk, but of course the LA and the school are seeking assurance to be sure.

However Tillery St has all the required fire safety standards such as sprinkler systems, fire shutters, fire detection, testing and inspection regime, regular fire drills and trained staff so all fire risks are managed to the highest standard. This is audited by the LA's health and safety advisors.
